For over 100 years, the family-owned Grovert Chevrolet of Newhall, lowa has serviced the vehicle needs of Benton County. In spring of 2004, they opened their new 28,900 s.f. facility for new and used cars, which was designed by Brost Architects and Planners.

The design incorporates a unique system of insulated precast wall panels, furred out on the inside with sheet rock to provide the building with both a sturdy and energy efficient skin. With the use of precast wall panels, the building was able to be constructed in a relatively short and efficient manner.

The sleek rectilinear forms of the building along with the use of blue accents, creates a space that is professional and welcoming to customers, without distracting too much from the vehicles on display.
