For this project, the chief challenge was the adaptive reuse of an abandoned grocery store into a new class "A" office and meeting faculty.

The façade was re-surfaced with a lighter color brick, as can be seen in the "before and after" photos.

The facility also incorporates extensive use of daylighting techniques, most notably the conversion of the old grocery pick up lane into a sunny new vestibule, incorporating extensive plantings to create a welcoming entrance to the building.
